

Appendix 3: Domains in the Conceptual Framework for Culture Statistics¹

Culture Domains

Heritage and libraries

Core culture sub-domains within heritage and libraries include: archives; libraries; cultural heritage; and natural heritage.

Live performance

Core culture sub-domains within live performance include: performing arts; and festivals and celebrations.

Visual and applied arts

Core culture sub-domains within visual and applied arts include: original visual art; art reproduction; photography; and crafts. Ancillary culture sub-domains within visual and applied arts include: advertising; architecture; and design.

Written and published works

Core culture sub-domains within written and published works include: books; periodicals; newspapers; and other published works. Ancillary culture sub-domains within written and published works include collected information.

Audio-visual and interactive media

Core culture sub-domains within audio-visual and interactive media include: film and video; broadcasting; and interactive media.

Core culture sub-domains within sound recording include: sound recording; and music publishing.

Other Domains

Transversal domains

Transversal domains include: education and training; and governance, funding, and professional support.

Infrastructure domains include: mediating products; and physical infrastructure.
